Dr. Kajal Chheda introduced the eminent chief guest, Ms. Aprana Popat who shared her views about her opinion on importance of physical literacy along with her experience as professional badminton player.

- Chief Guest, Ms. Aprana Popat

Aparna Popat is a 2-time Olympian (badminton) and Arjuna Awardee. Her achievements include winning 4 medals at Commonwealth Games, a silver medal at the World Junior Championships (1st Indian to win a medal at this event) and winning 9-consecutive Senior National titles (equalling Padmashree Prakash Padukone’s national record). She was one of the 17 participants from around the world and the lone Indian to be selected for the 'Global Sports Mentoring Program', an initiative promoted by Hillary Clinton, US Secretary of State and EspnW. This prestigious program was aimed at empowering women and girls through sport.

Today, she works to contribute to Indian sport and society in various capacities through coaching, mentoring, sports administration, television commentary, writing columns, sitting on Government Committees and as former Executive Director of the Olympians Association of India. She believes strongly in the power of sports and is an advocate for the values of Olympism, Physical Literacy Movement, Women in Sports and Sports for All.

Experiential Workshop on Physical Literacy was conducted by Ms. Gita Krishna Raj (Program Director, Maverick Physical Literacy, Chennai) along with Ms. Ashrita Datta

(Fitness Entrepreneur, Tonabolic, Hyderabad) while, Dr. Amit Malik (Believer and Enabler Physical Literacy India Movement, Hyderabad) moderated the workshop.

Key Note Address by Mr. Nigel Green, Chair, International Physical Literacy Association (IPLA), UK

Nigel Green is currently a physical education and physical literacy consultant having been a Senior Lecturer in Physical Education at Liverpool John Moores University from 2009 - 2018. He taught physical education in four secondary schools for 29 years prior to this, during this time he led three departments, a faculty (including PE, Art, Music, Dance and Drama) and a networked community. Nigel has been involved in training teachers and providing professional development for over thirty years, in the UK and more recently in India, Brazil, Taiwan and other countries worldwide. Nigel is Chair of the International Physical Literacy Association (IPLA) and Vice Chair of the North Western Counties Physical Education Association. He demonstrates a commitment and passion to promote and support the development of physical education and physical literacy worldwide. He has written articles, delivered CPD, organised and presented workshops, webinars and conferences on physical literacy and physical education. Nigel is editor of the Research Matters section of the AfPE journal, Physical Education Matters and is currently working with schools, organisations and governments both in the UK and across the world.

Guest of Honour, Dr. Mohan Amrule, Director, Sports & Physical Education, University of Mumbai shared about Sports Rule Book of University of Mumbai as well as updates regarding zonal structure, fund & grants allocation, events etc.
