Gymkhana & Sports Committee organized various events in the academic year 2021-22 for the students as well as staff focusing mainly on creating awareness on Health, Wellness, Healthy Lifestyle as well as Physical Literacy. Though Gymkhana Committee is committed to give optimum opportunities to all the students of our degree college to explore the field of Physical Education and Sports through various activities but, due to Covid Pandemic situation only restricted number of

Gymkhana Committee conducted various activities & events in the academic year 2021-2022.

### **1] INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY:**

The Gymkhana and Sport Committee organized yoga workshop in collaboration with NSS Unit of college on 21st June 2021. The Ministry of AYUSH's protocol for yoga day celebration was followed. The resource person Mr. Sudhir Sawant of Shri. Ambika Yoga Kutir conducted the yoga workshop with 129 students and 3 staff.

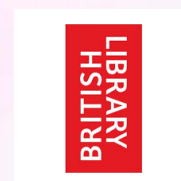

## **LIBRARY**

## યોજનાઓ અને વાસ્તવિકતા

દેશની ચાલીસ ટકા વસ્તીની જરૂરિયાતો પૂરી કરવાનું વચન આપીને વડાપ્રધાન નરેન્દ્ર મોદીએ પોતાની પ્રિય ત્રણ મહત્વાકાંક્ષી યોજનાઓની શરૂઆત કરી છે. 'સબકે લિએ આવાસ' યોજનાનું લક્ષ્ય 2020 સુધી દેશમાં બધા જ પરિવારોને ઘર ઉપલબ્ધ કરાવવાનું છે. સ્માર્ટ સિટી પ્રોજેક્ટ અંતર્ગત 100 શહેરોને 24 કલાક વીજળી-પાણી, વિશ્વસ્તરની પરિવહન વ્યવસ્થા, શ્રેષ્ઠ શિક્ષણ અને મનોરંજન સુવિધાઓ, ઈ-ગવર્નન્સ, પર્યાવરણ સમ્મત વાતાવરણ અને અન્ય સુવિધાઓ ઉપલબ્ધ કરાવવાનું સપનું છે. વડાપ્રધાને સ્માર્ટ સિટીની વ્યાખ્યા કરતા જણાવ્યું છે કે, આ એવા શહેર હશે જ્યાં નાગરિક કંઈ ઈચ્છા કરે એ પહેલાં જ તેને બધી સુવિધા મળી જશે. અટલ શહેરી પુનરુદ્ધાર અને રૂપાંતરણ મિશનનો હેતુ 1 લાખથી વધુ વસ્તી ધરાવતા 500 શહેરોમાં માળખાકીય સુવિધાઓ તૈયાર કરવાનું છે. તેનો ઉદ્દેશ્ય એ પણ છે કે આગળ જતાં આ શહેર પણ સ્માર્ટ સિટીમાં બદલાઈ જાય. સરકારે ઊંચું સપનું જોયું છે, જેના માટે તેમની સામે પડકાર પણ ઊંચા છે. સૌથી મોટો મુદ્દો નાણાની ઉપલબ્ધતાનો છે. 'સબકે લિએ આવાસ' માટે બે કરોડ મકાન બનાવવાના છે. જેના પાછળ રૂ.3 ખરબનો ખર્ચ થશે. અને એટલા મકાન માટે જમીનની જરૂર પડશે. પરંતુ શું તેનો તમામ ખર્ચ કેન્દ્ર ઉઠાવશે. કે પછી રાજ્યોએ પણ જવાબદારી લેવી પડશે જમીન આમ પણ રાજ્યની યાદીમાં આવે છે. એટલે કે રાજ્યોની ઉત્સાહપૂર્ણ ભાગીદારી આ યોજનાની સફળતાની અનિવાર્ય શરત હશે. સ્માર્ટ સિટી યોજના પર પણ અનેક સવાલ પેદા થયા છે. સરકારોએ પોતાનાં સંસાધનોનો વધુ ઉપયોગ કર્યો તો એવી ફરિયાદ આવી શકે છે કે કેટલાક શહેરોના સ્માર્ટ બનવાની કિંમત બીજા શહેર અને કસબા ઉઠાવી રહ્યા છે. સ્માર્ટ શહેરોમાં તેમાં રહેતા ગરીબોને કેવી રીતે મોઢી સુવિધાઓ ઉપલબ્ધ કરાવાશે એ સ્પષ્ટ કરાયું નથી. અટલ મિશન કુલ મળીને જવાહરલાલ નેહરુ શહેરી નવીનીકરણ યોજનાનું જ બદલાયેલું સ્વરૂપ છે. યુપીએની આ યોજનાઓ જે કારણે સફળ થઈ નથી, શું એનડીએ સરકારે તેનો ઉકેલ શોધી કાઢ્યો છે. આ ત્રણેય યોજનાઓ કરોડોનું જીવન બદલી નાખે એવી છે, પરંતુ સરકાર તેના અમલીકરણની સમગ્ર યોજના પણ રજૂ કરતી તો વિશ્વાસ વધુ પાકો થતો...
